# Elegibility criteria

- **Early-career researchers**  
≤ 10 years of graduation\*
- **Residency within the specified region**
- **Upper-intermediate proficiency in English**  
At least B2 level according to the CEFR
- **Submission of a manuscript relevant to the field of toxicology, together with the completed MP Application Form, by the established deadline**

\*Senior applicants may be considered on a case-by-case basis
